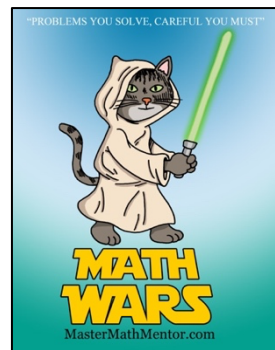


# Math Wars – AB Calculus

## Topic 105 – Chain Rule

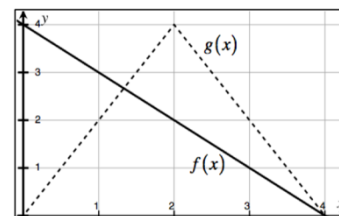
